NORFOLK HUNT HORSE SHOW | RULES

1. EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULES BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.
2. Entries Close May 20. They must be made on official forms and signed by each exhibitor, rider, driver, handler and trainer(s), or his/ her agent(s). If the owner is less than 21 years old, the entry blank must be signed by a representative who is of age and who by such signature individually assumes responsibility and risk as stated above signature. The entry blank must include the exhibitor's home address and zip code.
3. Refunds of entry fees will not be made unless a vet or doctor's certificate of lameness, injury, or illness is shown. A scratch fee of \$30.00 will be charged.
4. Post-entries will be charged a fee of \$30.00.
5. There will be an Office Fee of \$30.00 charged to each horse showing.
6. The Show Management reserves the rights to vary or change show officials or judges, move, cancel, divide or combination of classes.
7. **Please remember to bring your Pony and Junior Hunter measurement cards. Numbers will not be issued without them. ATTENTION ALL ENTRIES: * An open check must be left in the office to obtain your number. THIS REQUIREMENT INCLUDES ALL HORSES AND RIDERS.***
8. Proper attire must be worn by a competitor at all times. **All riders must wear protective headgear at all times while mounted.**
9. A schooling area will be provided. No poling allowed.
10. Dogs MUST be leashed at all times. A \$100 fine will be levied automatically on the entry form if a loose dog is found and identified.
11. A minor must have a valid driver's license issued by their state of residence in order to operate a motorized vehicle on competition grounds.
12. A trophy and/ or cash and eight ribbons will be awarded in all classes unless otherwise stated. Ribbons will be awarded at ringside during the show at completion of classes. Prize money will be automatically deducted from your entry fees. Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons along with trophies must be picked up at the trophy tent.
13. Current USEF rules relating to drugs and medications will be enforced. Each horse entered must pay the \$15.00 Drug and Medication Fee plus \$8.00 US Equestrian Federation fee.
14. Proof of negative coggins must accompany each horse as it enters the Norfolk Hunt Horse Show grounds. Test must be dated within 6 months for out-of-state horses and 24 months for Massachusetts horses.
15. A \$25 fee for all warm-ups. Tickets at show office.
16. General Parking: Vans and trailers only will be parked in an area near the rings. Limit of one vehicle may park in upper lot with vans containing 4+ horses. General car parking will be at by horse show office, and overflow will park in the lower field as necessary.
17. An EMT will be on the grounds during show hours.
18. A farrier will be on the grounds during show hours.
19. All hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted.
20. If in the case of a Cooler or Perpetual trophy class being divided, the highest total points receives the trophy — or in the case of a tie, a coin toss decides.
21. Entries for all classes are limited to 40 except for low hunters.
22. Food Service is available on show grounds.
23. Sharps receptacle is located in the Horse Show Office.
24. Dimensions of Show Rings and Footing: Jumper Ring 1 - 250' x 150' grass, Hunter Ring 2 - 250" x 125' grass, Ring 3 - 200' x 100' grass, Warm Up areas on grass.
25. **Stalls available upon request off the show grounds**

USEF Membership Statement

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR218) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION DIVISION

Unrated USEF, Rated "AA", NEHC, MHC, SEHA. Entry fee for each class \$30. Open to riders 12 years of age or under. Not to compete in any other equitation classes at any show and have not competed in a jumping class exceeding 18" in height. To be judged at a walk, trot, & canter with only 8 riders to canter at a time. *Snowy River Championship Trophy & Ribbons.*

LEADLINE DIVISION

Unrated USEF. Rated "C" MHC. Entry fee for each class \$25.

4. **Leadline Equitation**-Open to riders 6 years of age and under, who have not competed in any other class except for leadline. To be judged on equitation only.
5. **Leadline Suitability**- same specs as class 4, but judged on suitability of mount to rider
6. **Leadline Championship**- Same specifications as classes 4&5. Judge both on equitation and suitability.

WALK TROT DIVISION

Unrated USEF, Rated "AA" NEHC, MHC, SEHA. Classes 7 & 8. Unrated USEF, rated "C" NEHC, MHC, SEHA classes 9 & 10. Entry fee for each class \$25. Open to all riders 10 years of age or under. To be shown at a walk and trot only. Open to horses or ponies. Riders must not have been judged in a class at a show that required a canter or lope. No child entered may compete in any other class requiring entries to canter or lope. *Innisbofin Chipmunk Memorial Perpetual Trophy* (Classes 7-11 to count).

22. SEHA Mini-Medal- Entry fee \$40. Open to junior members of SEHA who have not reached their 15th birthday. Open to riders who have not competed in classes in which the entry is required to jump higher than 3'. All contestants are to compete over a course not exceeding 8 fences and not less than 6 fences, at a height not to exceed 2'6". One of more individual tests may be requested at the judge's discretion (USEF current tests 1-5). To fill a class at least 4 competitors must complete the course. Contestants may not cross-enter into the USET or the ASPCA Horsemanship classes at any show during the year.

23. NHS 3'3" Equitation Championship- Entry fee \$45. The National Horse Show 3'3" Equitation Championship will be open to junior members of USEF or Equine Canada who have not reached their 18th birthday and who have never competed in any of the following National Equitation Finals with fences at 3'6": ASPCA Maclay Finals, US Medal Finals, USEF Talent Search (East or West), WIHS Equitation Classic Finals, Jump Canada Medal Finals or the North American Equitation Championship. Riders to be judged over no less than eight obstacles set at a height of 3'3". The over fences if followed by a Flat Phase that requires riders to be judged at the walk, trot, & canter. A final list of riders will be asked to return to the ring for a second course with the same specifications. The testing of up to six riders is optional, using USEF Tests 1-18.

24. MHJ Junior Medal- Entry fee \$40. Open to all junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 2, 2015. Riders shall perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3'. One or more individual tests of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. To fill a class and for points to count, at least two riders must complete the course.

25 & 133. MHC Mini Medal- Entry fee \$40. Open to junior members of MHC who have not reached their 15th birthday as of December 1st of the current year, and have not competed in classes in which the entry is required to jump higher than 3'. All contestants are to compete over a course not exceeding 8 fences and not less than 6 fences, excluding combination fences, at a height not to exceed 2'6". One or more individual tests may be requested at the judge's discretion. USEF Test 1-5. To fill a class, at least 4 competitors must complete the course. Ten points qualified for the finals. Once qualified, riders may not compete in this class.

26. MHJ Mini Medal- Entry fee \$40. Open to junior riders who have not reached their 15th birthday as of December 1st with the exception of Maiden and Novice riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st. To perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 2'6". Riders may not cross enter into the MHJ Children's Medal Horse of Children's pony medal at the finals. Ten points are required to qualify for the finals. To fill a class and for points to count, at least two riders must complete the course. Once qualified, riders may continue to compete in the class.

27. THIS Children's Medal- Entry fee \$45. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences 2'9" to 3' in height, spread not to exceed fence height. The course may be either a hunter or jumper type course and must include at least 2 changes of direction and a combination. Water obstacles (i.e. water jump,

liverpool) are not permitted. The top 4 riders or 20% of the first round competitors, whichever is greater, are required to perform at least 2 individual tests. USEF Tests 1-19. An Open numerical scoring system must be used in the first round, with each rider's score announced at the completion of their round. At least 6 ribbons shall be awarded in each qualifying class.

28. USHJA Jumping Seat Medal (3'3")- Entry fee \$45. Open to junior riders. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at 3'3" (1.0m) in height, at least one double or triple combination, and at least three spreads from 1.0m to 1.15m (3'3" to 3'9"). Natural fences, a Liverpool, and a small water jump may also be included at the course designer's discretion. Riders must be current Active members of USEF and USHJA prior to the start of the class.

29. MHC Junior Hunt Seat Medal 1- Entry fee \$40. Open to junior members of the Massachusetts Horseman's Council who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current year. All contestants are required to perform over a course of at least 8 fences not exceeding 3'. One or more individual tests of the top 4 competitors may be requested at the judge's discretion. USEF tests 1-18. To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course. Ten points required to qualify for the finals. Once qualified, riders may not show in this class.

30. MHC Junior Hunt Seat Medal 2- Entry fee \$40. See description of class 29.

31. SEHA Junior Medal- Entry fee \$40. Open to junior members of SEHA who have not reached their 18th birthday. All contestants are to compete over a course not exceeding 8 fences with height not exceed 3' in height. One of more tests of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. USEF tests 1-19. To fill, at least 4 competitors must complete the course. Ten points required to qualify for the finals (10, 6, 4, 2, 1, .5). Once qualified, you may still enter the class. If you won the junior medal at the finals, you are no longer eligible for this class.

32. NEHC Hunt Seat Medal- Entry fee \$40. Open to Junior Members of the NEHC who have not reached their 18th birthday. All contestants are required to perform over a course of at least 8 fences not exceeding 3'3". One or more individual tests of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. USEF tests 1-18. To fill a class, at least four must complete the course. One win required to qualify for the finals. Once qualified, rider is no longer eligible for the preliminary class. Violation will forfeit eligibility for the finals for that year.

33. Dover Saddlery/USEF Hunter Seat Medal- Entry fee \$40. Open to junior members of USEF who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current year. To be shown over a course of not less than 8 obstacles at 3'6" which must include one combination including an oxer and two changes of direction (change of lead) after the first obstacle. To fill a class, 6 competitors must complete the course.

34. NHSAA/ASPCA Medal Class- Entry fee \$40. Open to junior members of ASPCA who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current year. Must show their

ASPCA number on the entry blank. To be shown over at least 8 fences not exceeding 3'6". The under saddle performance of those riders selected to show under saddle shall count 50%. To fill a class, three competitors must complete the course.

35. Back On Track Children's Medal- Entry fee \$40. Open to Junior Riders that are not competing in any class in which fences exceed 3'3". To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at 3' including a combination and at least two changes of direction. Two or more tests of the top 4 riders. Three riders must complete course for points to count. Rider can not cross-enter into M&S Children's Pony Medal.

36. SEHA Adult Amateur Hunt Seat Medal- Entry fee \$40. Open to all adult amateur members of SEHA. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3'. One of more individual tests of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. USEF tests 1-17. To fill a class, at least 4 competitors must complete the course.

Adult Amateur Hunt Seat Equitation -Entry fee \$30. Rated MHC, NEHC, AA. Open to all adult amateur competitors. Fences not to exceed 3'.

- 37. Adult Amateur Hunt Seat Equitation O/F
- 38. Adult Amateur Hunt Seat Flat

39. Bay State Adult Medal- Entry fee \$40. Open to adult amateur competitors. All entries are required to perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 2'6" in height. One or more individual tests of the top 4 contestants may be required at the judge's discretion. USEF tests 1-19. To fill a class, at least 4 competitors must complete the course.

MHJ Adult Mini Medal- Entry fee \$40. Open to all Adult Amateur riders that have not shown over a course where the fences exceeded 3' in the current year. To perform over a course of at least 8 fences not to exceed 2'6". Riders may not cross enter into the MHJ Adult Medal.

40. NEHC Adult Amateur Hunt Seat Medal- Entry fee \$40. Open to Adult Amateur members of the NEHC. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3'. One or more individual tests of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. USEF tests 1-17. To fill a class, at least 4 competitors must complete the course.

41. Ariat National Adult Medal- Entry fee \$40. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences not to exceed 3' in height, spread not to exceed fence height. The course may be either a jumper or hunter type course and must include at least two changes of direction and a combination. Water obstacle (i.e. water jump, liverpool) are not permitted. The top 4 riders are required to perform at least 2 individual tests. USEF tests 1-19. An open numerical scoring system must be used in the first round, which each rider's score announced at the completion of their round. At least 6 ribbons shall be awarded in each qualifying class.

42. MHJ Adult Medal- Entry fee \$40. Open to all Adult Amateur riders. Riders shall perform over at least 8 fences 2'9" to 3' including a combination with at least two changes of direction after the first fence. One or more individual test of the

top four contestants may be required at the judge's discretion. To fill a class and for points to count, at least two riders must finish the course. Once qualified riders may continue to show in the class until August 8th. After August 8th, only those riders not qualified may continue to compete in the class.

43 & 134. MHC Adult Medal- Entry fee \$40. Open to Adult members of MHC. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences 2'6"-2'9" with at least one change of direction. 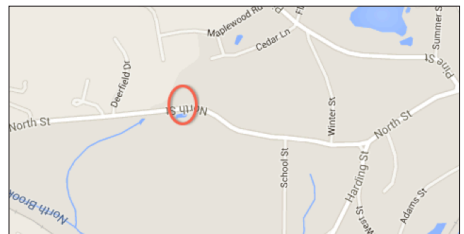
